

ST WENN NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN COMMUNITY QUESTIONNAIRE – FEBRUARY 2020

Neighbourhood Development Plans give local communities a say in the way their community develops in the future through the Planning system. The law says that when a Neighbourhood Plan has been approved, it becomes **official planning policy, and must be considered when planning application decisions are made.**

St Wenn Parish Council has decided, following a public meeting, to produce such a Plan to cover the period to 2030, and has set up a Steering Group to help create it.

To begin the Steering Group need to get an idea of what the community of the Parish thinks are the most important issues that the new Plan should cover. This questionnaire has been created to collect our community's views.

Please spend a little time to fill out the questionnaire thoughtfully. Consider your own position but please think also of the wider community, and how one issue might impact on another.

It's also worth noting that not all issues can be controlled through a Neighbourhood Plan: basically, it's about things that require Planning Permission and can be controlled through Cornwall Council's Planning powers.

All persons in St Wenn Parish over 14 years and over are encouraged to fill in this questionnaire and return it to the Steering Group.

ps. There will be more consultation when the draft Plan is produced in Spring 2020.
